

The questionnaire of the Innova survey about school level innovations in Hungary

This is the English translation of the text of the electronic questionnaire sent out to the heads of all units providing education in the Hungarian education system (including kindergartens, basic schools, secondary general and vocational schools, university departments, doctoral schools and private adult education providers) in October/November of 2016.¹

*This is one of the data collection instruments used in the **Innova research project**. The Innova research project was launched in early 2016 by the Higher Education and Innovation Research Group of the Institute of Education of ELTE University, Budapest.² The project aims at better understanding the emergence, diffusion and systemic impact of local/school level innovations in the education sector. By the end of December more than 4500 questionnaires have been sent back by the contacted educational units.*
